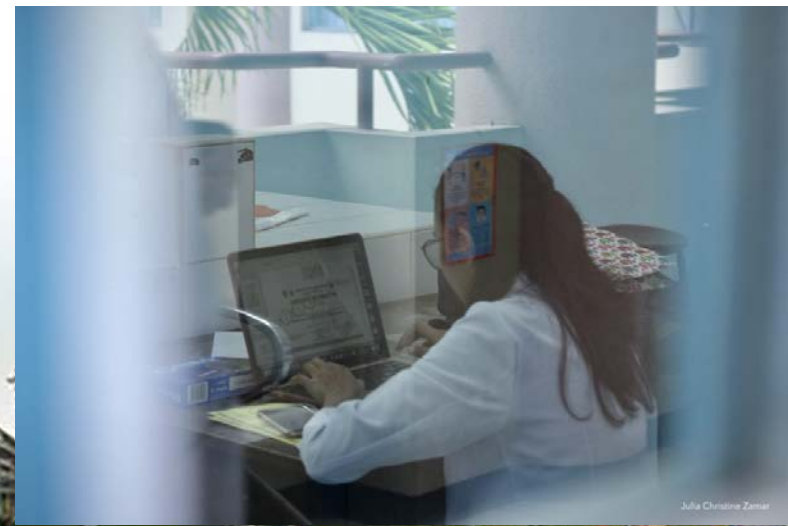

SUBJECT : EXTENSION OF THE VALIDITY PERIOD OF AUTONOMOUS AND DEREGULATED STATUS GRANTED TO PRIVATE HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS FROM JUNE 1, 2021 TO MAY 31, 2023

In accordance with the pertinent provisions of Republic Act (RA) No. 7722 otherwise known as the "Higher Education Act of 1994"; in view of the on-going review of the criteria and guidelines for the grant of status as stated in CHED Memorandum Order No. 12, s. 2019; and by virtue of Commission en banc Resolution No. 193-2021, the Commission on Higher Education have **extended the validity period of the autonomous and deregulated status granted to private higher education institutions effective from June 1, 2021 until May 31, 2023.**

Within this extension period, all autonomous and deregulated HEIs shall continue to enjoy the benefits of their status provided under CHED Memorandum Order (CMO) No. 19, series of 2016. These HEIs are expected to observe their compliance with relevant CHED policies, standards and guidelines.

Attached is the list of autonomous and deregulated HEIs covered by this CMO.

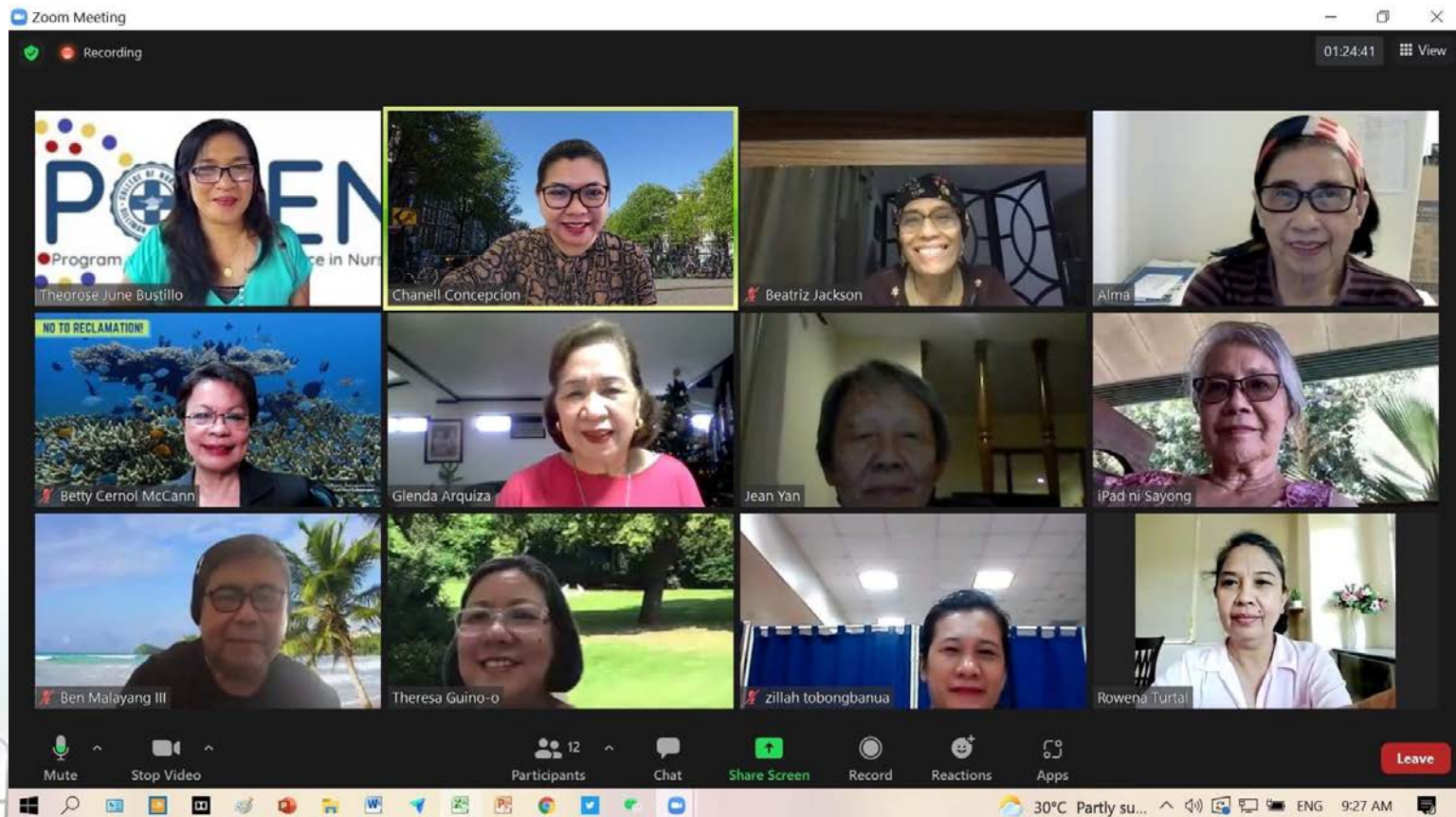

Soon to be integrated into the Nursing program structure is the Luz Sobong Porter Center of Leadership Excellence in Nursing (CoLEN), derived from the SUCN Program of Leadership Excellence in Nursing (PoLEN). The program advances “nursing education, research and policy development for improved health outcomes in the Philippines and ASEAN region” (MOU 2015). Further, it commits to opening new opportunities for aspiring and experienced leaders to address emerging challenges and imperatives of a healthy global world.





SU establishes a Psychological Research Laboratory following a donation made by the SU Psychology Department's Class of 1981 alumni. The Laboratory serves as a facility for the conduct of psychological experiments and research.

Dr. Rogen Ferdinand Alcantara, Psychology Department chair, welcomed alumni Leo O Fortugaleza, Brigitte Valencia, and Merlo Calumpang Fuentes who did an ocular visit, May 17, 2022, of the location at the Luz U. Ausejo Hall.





Dr. Rene A. Abesamis of the Silliman University Angelo King Center for Research and Environmental Management (SUAKCREM) trained local fishery leaders in South Negros on how to conduct their own fish surveys using an app, for them to independently monitor marine protected areas (MPAs) and manage fish resources.

A marine scientist specializing in MPAs, Abesamis was chosen by the Fish Right Program of USAID and the Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR) to lead the training.



Dr. Angel C. Alcala, National Scientist, BOT vice chair, and head of Silliman University Angelo King Center for Research and Environmental Management (SUAKCREM), shared the Board of Trustees view that it is Silliman's responsibility as an institution to protect and conserve wildlife on campus and the wider community as part of its research and advocacy on biodiversity since 1941.

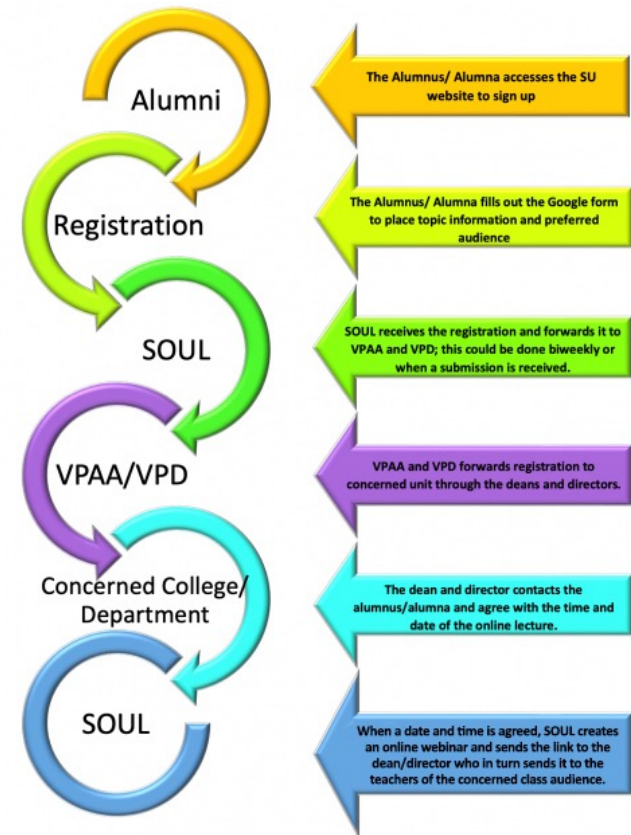
